



INFORMATION FROM SKYSS

Free transport for asylum seekers

From 1 February 2023, asylum seekers will be able to travel for free in Vestland with a valid asylum seeker certificate. This is a trial arrangement that will apply until further notice. The following text includes information about which types of transport are included and what is considered a valid travel document.

From 1 February 2023, the following applies:

- Asylum seekers with a valid asylum seeker certificate can travel for free on public transport in Vestland County. This includes Skyss buses, boats and the Bergen Lightrail, with some exceptions
 - Free travel is not available on the following boat services:
 - Tourist boat service Hardanger: Norheimsund – Eidfjord
 - Tourist boat service Flåm
- Free travel is not available on express buses.
- Free travel does not apply to cars on boats or ferries.

Information for passengers

Travel document – Valid asylum seeker certificate (Asylsøkarbevis)

A valid asylum seeker certificate will be accepted as a travel document on Skyss transport from 1 February. The certificate includes last name, first name, date of issue and date of expiration. In a ticket inspection, inspectors will check the date of expiration on the certificate.

Both the new and the old version of the certificate will be accepted as a travel document, provided the certificate is still valid.
